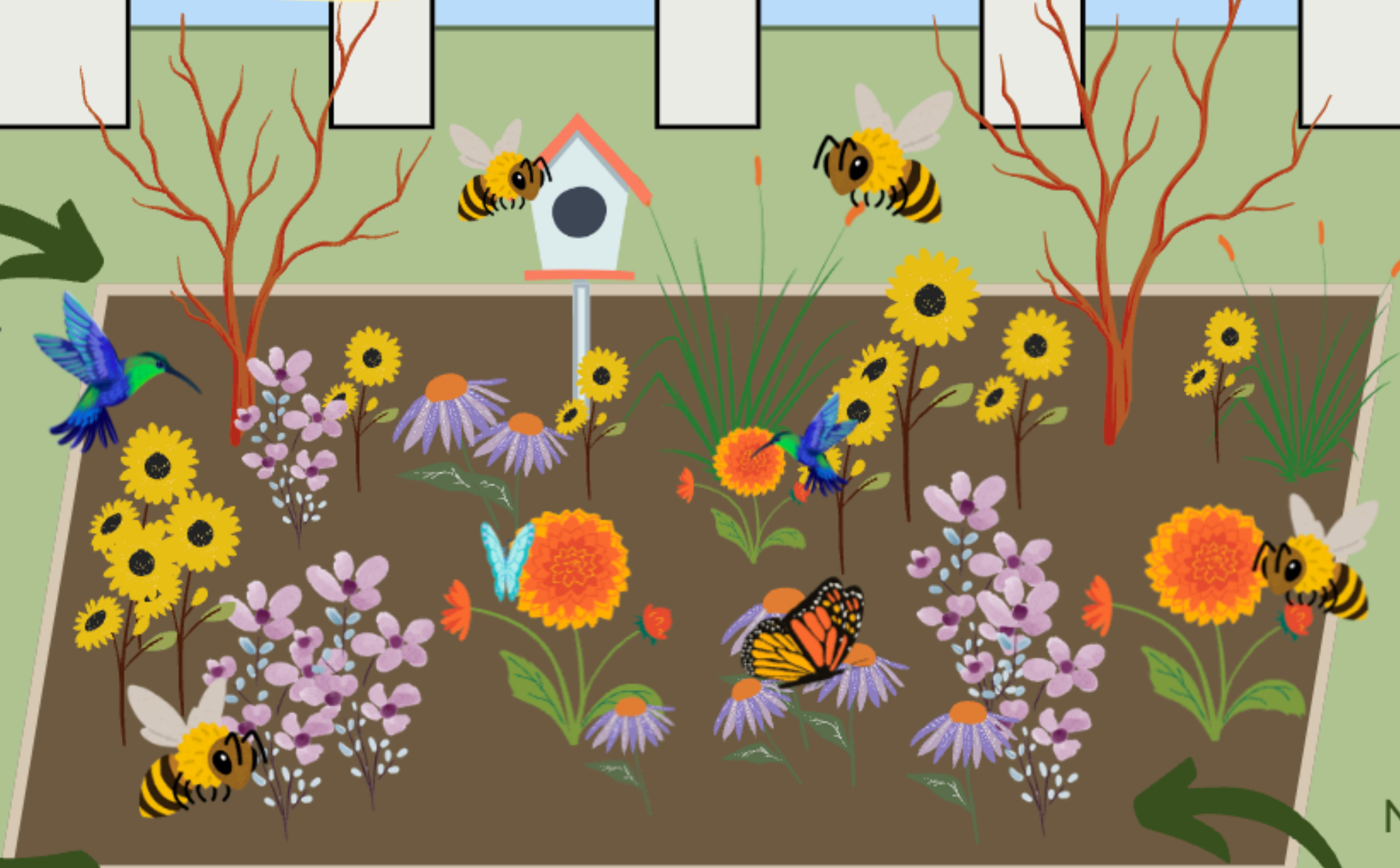

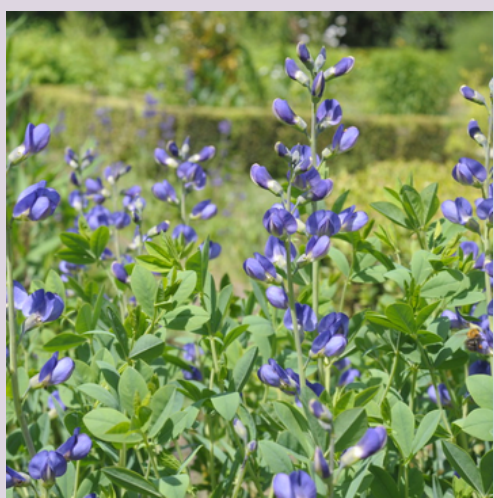

Wild Indigo



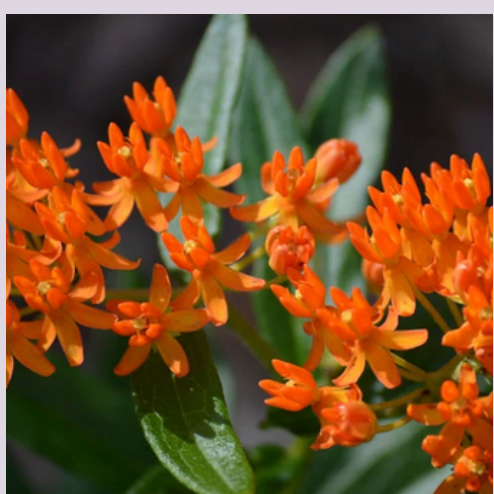
Red Twig Dogwood

Butterfly Weed

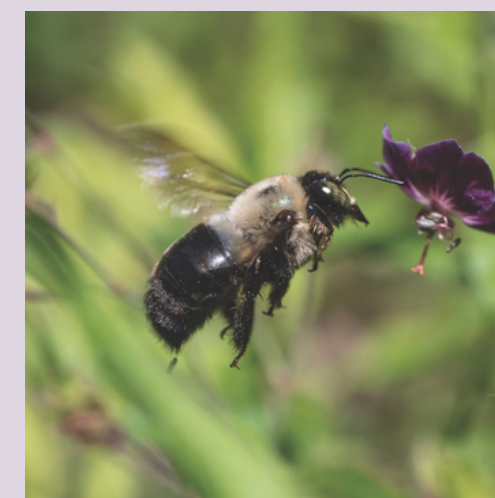


False Sunflower

We need these species and more to maintain a healthy ecosystem, allowing us to have clean air and successful food systems.

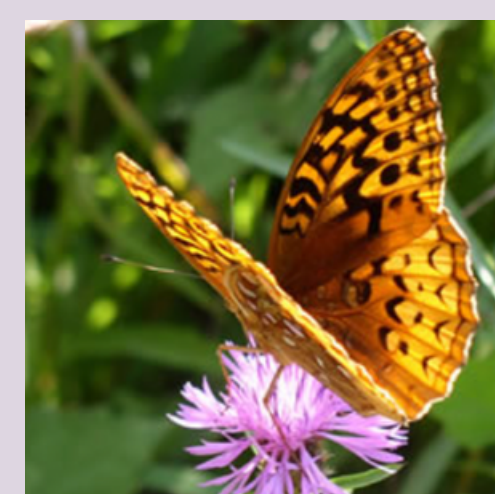

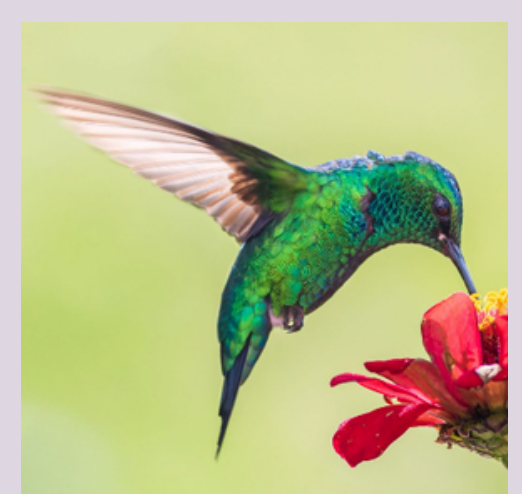

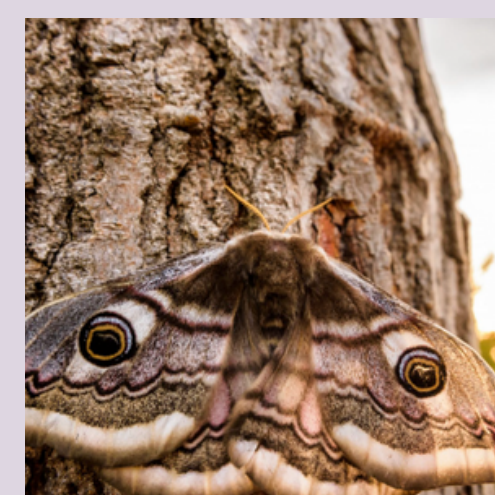
